

Holy Week rites

Since the 17th century the Holy Week rites of Cagliari have enabled the devotee to relive the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ.

As many others sardinian areas, Cagliari celebrates **Easter** (known as Sa Pasca Manna, in contrast to Sa Paschixedda, Christmas) combining the official liturgical ceremonies with others, held by the citizens over the centuries. Through those rites, the town keeps alive a centuries-old tradition of its four historical districts: Castello, Marina, Stampace and Villanova, together with their parish churches.
